

## Walpole Public Library Rules.

1. The library is open week days from 2 to 6 and 7 to 9 p. m. The reading rooms are open Sundays from 2 to 5 and 7 to 9.

2. The library is free to any responsible person resident in Walpole. Non-residents may take books for home use on payment of twenty-five cents quarterly.

3. Books may be kept out two weeks unless a shorter time is specified. Fourteen day books may be renewed once if application is made within the first fourteen days.

4. No book can be exchanged the same day on which it is loaned. Seven day books, when returned, must remain until the next opening of the library.

5. A fine of two cents for each calendar day shall be paid by any person retaining a book beyond the specified time. Books will not be delivered to any one who has incurred a fine of twenty-four cents, until it has been paid.

6. All injuries to books beyond a reasonable wear, and all losses shall be made good to the satisfaction of the trustees.

7. Writing or marking in books is prohibited.

8. Readers of non-fiction are allowed more than one book at a time.
